EXPLANATION

Since each believer is the Lord's workmanship, we pray and trust He will also strengthen and work within you to labor for His glory (Ephesians 2:10; Philippians 2:13). SEASONAL OPPORTUNITIES

Throughout the year, there are numerous events, seminars, conferences, and other opportunities to serve and edify the body at Carlsbad Community Church. These events are publicized throughout the year.

Some of these opportunities include, Summer Theology Seminars, Seasonal decorations, Women's Christmas Celebration, Christmas Concert, Membership and Baptism Classes, Missions Events, and other special outreach events.

HOSPITALITY MINISTRY

The Hospitality Ministry exists to welcome, serve, and love those who participate in the worship of our Lord during the gathering of His people. Jesus said that the world would know that we are His disciples by our love for one another (John 13:35), and the nation of Israel was to treat the stranger with the love of a brother (Leviticus 19:34). This ministry seeks to direct and serve those on our campus in practical ways.

WELCOME CENTER

The Welcome Center provides information a member, attender, or visitor might need about the church, ministries, events, and sign-ups. Those serving at the Welcome Center are trained to be knowledgeable about current events and information of the church, be ready at the center before and after the Worship Service, and provide visitors with a warm welcome and supplied gift. Membership is a requirement to serve on this team and frequency of serving is about one Sunday per month.

This ministry provides a warm welcome and also an initial Hospitality Ministry opportunity to provide direction, answer questions, and assist those on campus as needed. Those who serve as Greeters are to welcome individuals at the doors to the Worship Center prior to the service with a smile and loving disposition. They need to be knowledgeable about the campus and can direct individuals to the Welcome Center to answer questions they may have. Volunteers must be approved to serve on this team. Frequency of serving varies.

REFRESHMENTS

The Refreshments Ministry provides coffee and refreshments for those attending on a Sunday morning. These volunteers plan, prepare, set up, and attend the refreshments tables before and after services. Volunteers must be approved to serve on this team. Frequency of serving varies.

USHERS

Ushers provide direction and help to those attending the Worship Service within the Worship Center. Ushers help direct seating, hand out bulletins, provide materials for new visitors, collect the offering, and provide information and helps to those attending as needed. Ushers serve before and during the Worship Service as needed with gentleness, warmth, initiative, and care. Ushers may also help the elders serve communion. Membership is a requirement to serve on this team. Frequency of serving varies.

COMMUNION PREPARATION

The Communion Ministry provides and prepares the elements for the Lord's Table first Sunday of the month as well as other times Communion is scheduled. These volunteers supply the trays with the bread and juice and set up the trays on the front table of the Worship Center prior to the service. At the conclusion of the service, these volunteers clean up and put away Communion elements. Volunteers must be approved to serve on this team and serve on the 1st Sunday of each month.

BAPTISMS

The Baptism Ministry exists to support and assist those who are being baptized during the Sunday morning Worship Service. These volunteers encourage, pray for, and assist those being baptized prior to the service. They also direct them onto the stage and receive them after their baptism, providing what they need in the changing rooms. Membership is a requirement to serve on this team and frequency of serving is as needed when baptisms are scheduled.

CHILDREN'S & YOUTH MINISTRY

The Children's and Youth Ministries exist to supplement the parent's role in training and shepherding the next generation into the knowledge, fear, and love of the Lord (Proverbs 1:1-8; Ephesians 6:1-4). These ministries do so through Sunday morning Sunday School classes and midweek gatherings and events.

Frequency of serving in the Children's Ministry is as scheduled during Sunday School or the Worship Service. Frequency of serving with Adventure Club or Youth Ministry is every Wednesday evening throughout the school year. Youth Ministry requires a 1-year commitment.

CHILDREN'S CHECK-IN

The Children's Check-In volunteers assist the Children's Ministry Director by taking the responsibility of welcoming parents and students on Sunday mornings and properly checking the children into the ministry. These volunteers sit at the entrance of the Children's Ministry building, allowing authorized individuals access to the classrooms, entering students into the registration software, printing check-in tags, and providing information to parents as needed. Volunteers must be approved to serve on this team.

NURSERY LEADERS

The Nursery Leaders oversee and serve in the Nursery during the Sunday School and Worship Service hours. The Nursery cares for those from birth through 4 years old. The Nursery Leaders give oversight to the Nursery, leading and caring for the babies and toddlers in the Nursery, and directing the Nursery Helpers for assistance. Members who have been background checked, have an approved application, and have agreed to the Nursery guidelines and directives may serve on this team.

NURSERY HELPERS

The Nursery Helpers assist in serving in the Nursery during the Sunday School and Worship Service hours. The Nursery cares for those from birth through 4 years old. These volunteers follow the lead of, and provide assistance to, the Nursery Leaders in caring for the babies and toddlers in the Nursery. Approved volunteers who have been background checked, have an approved application, and have agreed to the Nursery guidelines and directives may serve on this team.

PRESCHOOL & ELEMENTARY LEADERS

The Children's Leaders serve, teach, and lead the classroom during the Sunday School hour. The Children's Leaders may serve in the 3-5 years old class, 1st-3rd grade class, or 4th-6th grade class. The Children's Leader studies the Generations of Grace curriculum throughout the week in order to accurately and biblically present the passage of Scripture and main point at the appropriate age level. Leaders also manage and direct the class through their necessary activities during the Sunday School gathering. Members who have been background checked, have an approved application, have demonstrated giftedness in teaching, agree with the CCC statement of faith, and are able to agree with, prepare, and accurately teach the Generations of Grace curriculum may serve on this team.

PRESCHOOL & ELEMENTARY HELPERS

The Children's Helpers serve, support the teaching, and assist in directing the classroom during the Sunday School hour. The Children's Helpers may serve in the 3-5 years old class, 1st-3rd grade class, or 4th-6th grade class. The Children's Helper also studies the Generations of Grace lesson throughout the week in order to support the Leader in the study and teaching. The Helper comes alongside the Leader to help and assist in the direction and leading of the classroom activities and oversight of the children during the Sunday School gathering. Approved volunteers who have been background checked, have an approved application, have demonstrated a desire to help a teacher, agree with the CCC statement of faith, and are able to agree with, prepare, and support the Generations of Grace curriculum may serve on this team.

ADVENTURE CLUB LEADERS

Members who have been background checked, have an approved application, have demonstrated giftedness in teaching, agree with the CCC statement of faith, and are able to support and assist in the Adventure Club curriculum and program may serve on this team.

Approved volunteers who have been background checked by the Children's Director, have an approved application, agree with the CCC statement of faith, and are able to support and assist in the Adventure Club curriculum and program may serve on this team.

YOUTH LEADERS

The Youth Leaders serve and assist in the Youth Group Ministry of CCC. The Youth Ministry meets Wednesday evenings, with occasional special events designed to serve the young men and women of CCC, seeking to evangelize and disciple them to spiritual maturity. Youth Leaders set the example in godly living and spiritual disciplines. Leaders conduct small group discussions, lead prayer, direct games, and help give general oversight to the youth. Members who have been background checked, have an approved application, agree with the CCC statement of faith, are able to support and assist in the CCC philosophy of Youth Ministry, and lead a small group of junior high or high school students biblically, righteously, and by example may serve on this team.

MUSIC MINISTRY

Music Ministry exists to exalt Christ and lead His people in true worship through song on Sunday mornings, and at other ministry events. The Lord has commanded that His people worship Him through music (Psalm 100:2; 150), and this ministry leads God's people to do so in spirit and truth (John 4:24). Because God is so worthy, this ministry seeks to worship the Lord with the excellence and skill that He is due. Frequency of serving in Music Ministry is as scheduled and directed by the Music Pastor or Choir Director.

PRAISE TEAM

The Praise Team is comprised of both instrumentalists and vocalists who lead the congregation in worship through song each gathering. This team meets to rehearse Sunday mornings before our Worship Service. Membership is required to serve on this team, and instrumentalists or vocalists must be approved by the Music Pastor through an audition.

CHOIR

Membership is required to serve in the choir and all must be approved by Choir Director through an audition.

MEMORIALS & WEDDINGS

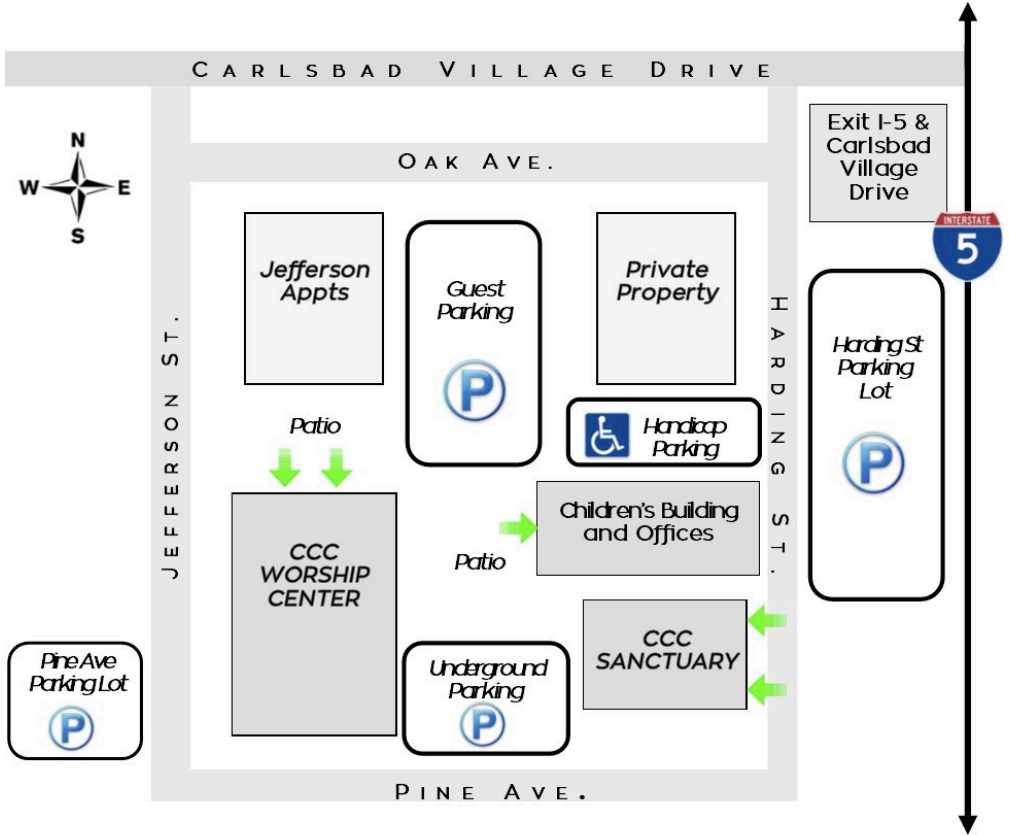
The Memorials and Weddings Ministry assists in the planning, arranging, organizing, and logistics of memorials and weddings for the members of CCC.
