Information for Artists

Welcome from Pastor Rick Uhls

Almost all faith traditions have a history of telling the stories of their faith through the arts. This commonality of the importance of art in the religions of the world can be a unifying force in this time where division is so rampant. In that spirit we have chosen Unity as the theme of the 2020 Beacon Art Show. We look forward to hosting this show once again and to experiencing how you use your God given talent to express the theme of Unity.

General Information for Artists

Any medium, except giclee, will be considered for display during the show period, which runs from March 6 through April 5, 2020. All events associated with the Beacon Art Show 2020 will be held at the San Luis Obispo United Methodist Church (SLOUMC), 1515 Fredericks Street, San Luis Obispo, CA 93405. Viewing by the public will be from 11AM until 4PM, Thursday through Sunday. Spiritually themed work will receive a favorable interpretation of acceptable quality and is highly encouraged. The Beacon Art Committee will take a liberal view of spiritual designs or motifs.

You may submit up to five of your original works of art produced during the past three years. Work submitted previously will not be accepted. Work should be complete, dry and ready for display/hanging. Two-dimensional works must be submitted with appropriate frames and hooks for wire 1/3 down from top. The Beacon Art Committee will supply 2 threaded eyes for the back top corners and hanging hooks. Three-dimensional works should be submitted with a base and/or display stands if desired.

Two-dimensional works shall not exceed 25 square feet and shall not weigh more than 100 pounds. Three-dimensional works shall not exceed 100 cubic feet and shall not weigh more than 300 pounds. The Beacon Art Committee reserves the right to make exceptions to these dimension/weight constraints.

By submitting artwork, the artist agrees that SLOUMC is not responsible for loss of or damage to any artwork. SLOUMC will make every reasonable effort to keep artwork safe, but the artist assumes all responsibility for the work during transport, set-up and while on display at SLOUMC. The artist may wish to provide his or her own insurance.

Sales

If artwork is for sale, SLOUMC will assist artists by collecting the sale price (prices may not be changed) and tax of 7.75%. SLOUMC will notify the artist of sales and forward the buyer's check to the artist by mail. SLOUMC will take no commission. Sold pieces will remain on display through the end of the art show.

Awards

SLOUMC may award a purchase prize (capped at \$1,000). Additionally, six merit awards will be offered: one each at \$300, \$250, \$150, and three at \$100.

Submitting Applications

The deadline for submitting applications is 5:00 PM, Monday, January 27, 2020. A five-page document with Information for Artists and the Application form may be downloaded and printed from the church's website: www.sloumc.com

Acceptance

This is a juried show. Dr. Ruta Saliklis, Director, SLO Museum of Art, Lori Wolf, visual artist and Rev. Rick Uhls, Pastor, San Luis Obispo United Methodist Church will serve as jurors. The jury's decision is final. Notification of acceptance will be made electronically by February 9, 2020. The artist gives permission to SLOUMC to use photographs of accepted artwork for publicity, the show catalog or for educational purposes. Upon actual receipt of the artwork for display, the Beacon Art Committee reserves the right to omit any work from the exhibition if it is not original artwork, is inconsistent in quality with the submitted image, is poorly framed, or otherwise has been misrepresented.

Delivering Artwork

Deliver artwork to SLOUMC, 1515 Fredericks Street, San Luis Obispo, CA 93405. Follow directional signs to the church's main entrance. Delivery times are: Monday, February 24, between 11AM –4PM. Please submit a one page Artist's Statement for the exhibit binder.

Opening Reception & "Art After Dark"

An Opening Reception will be held at SLOUMC on March 6, 2020, from 6PM until 9PM. Awards will be announced at this time. The opening reception for Beacon Art Show 2020 will also be part of "Art After Dark," a program coordinated by ARTS Obispo. Artists are encouraged to attend and mingle with the public. Retrieving Artwork

Works of art will be available for pickup by either the artist or purchaser after the show is completed on Monday, April 1, 2019, from 11AM until 4PM. If someone else is picking up your work, they need to have written permission from you to do so, and we will require a signed copy. If works of art are not picked up by 2PM on April 8, 2019, the artwork will be donated to the United Methodist Children's Center.

Application Checklist

APPLICATION FORM:

- Complete one application form for each work of art submitted for consideration.

SUBMITTAL FEE:

- For each work of art submitted, include the nonrefundable \$15.00 submittal fee (for example, 2 pieces - \$30; 5 pieces - \$75). Submit one check for the total amount payable to "SLOUMC." In the memo portion write: "Beacon Art Show 2020." **We do not accept credit cards or PayPal.**

ARTIST'S INFORMATION:

- Include biography, resume, show record and/or artist statement. Some or all of this information will be used in publicity including, but not limited to, the show catalog and/or an "artist's statement" binder. *[If you don't want some information included, specifically state that on your application form.]*

IMAGES:

- Prior to 5:00 PM on January 27, submit a digital image in .jpg format for each work of art to: beaconartshow@gmail.com Upload a single digital image of each work entered. Files **must** be submitted in a JPEG format with a **maximum** file size of 6 MB (smaller files are acceptable).

Images should be of adequate size and resolution to provide an accurate representation of the artwork.

- **e-mail subject line** must include Beacon Art Show 2020 (BAS 2020) and Artist's Name. [Example: **Subject: BAS 2020— Your Name**]
- **file names** for the .jpgs attached must include the artist's name and title of artwork [Example: **Your Name – Name of Your Art.jpg**]

- If submitting a digital image is not possible, artists may include a photograph of their artwork with the application package.

APPLICATION DEADLINE and DELIVERY:

- Complete application packages must be received no later than 5:00 PM on January 27, 2020.
- Clearly label the outside of the package: **Beacon Art Show 2020.**
